- Corporate profit tax
- Land tax and property tax
- Uniform tax payment by legal entities

Involvement of foreign direct investments entitles to exemption from:

- Corporate profit tax
- Property tax
- Improvement and social infrastructure development tax
- Uniform tax payment by micro-firms and small businesses
- Contributions to Republican Road Fund

Term of exemption depends on FDI amount

- 300 USD ths 3 USD mn 3 years
- 3 USD mn 10 USD mn 5 years
- >10 USD mn -7 years

Import duties

Profit tax etc.



Exemption from customs duties (with the exception of customs processing fees) for imported equipment, machinery, components, spare parts and materials not produced in the Republic of Uzbekistan

Payroll taxes for foreign specialists



Exemption until January 1, 2022, from:

- Uniform social payment for qualified foreign specialists employed to managers
- Individual income tax for qualified foreign specialists invited as hotel managers
